2023/166 Declarations of Interest There were no declarations of interest.

2023/167 Somerset Council Councillor Report

Cllr Dance once again advised that the Somerset Council is not in a good position. He reiterated the dire position financially that the Council finds themselves in. The cost of adult and childcare services makes up a huge portion of the budget, including care homes which have been underfunded by the Government. Many services will no longer be provided by Somerset Council free of charge. He recommended the Parish Council put the precept up by at least 15% next year.

2023/169 Planning Application

a) 23/02390/FUL: Ilton Cricket Club Copse Lane, Ilton

Proposed extension to the existing Cricket Clubhouse to enable creation of new Home and Away team shower facilities, accessible through existing changing rooms.

The council agreed to submit a 'SUPPORT' response on the basis it would be good for the community. The Cricket Club are very supportive and involved in both children/disabled cricket as well as adult cricket.

The response will be submitted to Somerset Council Planning and will subsequently be available on the respective application on the Planning Portal
